Grand List of October 1, 2023

**Taxes are Due July 1, 2024**

**FINAL DATE FOR AN ON-TIME PAYMENT IS AUGUST 1, 2024**

The first half installment of Real Estate and Personal Property taxes on the Grand List of October 1, 2023 is due July 1, 2024, and payable on August 1, 2024. All taxes under \$100.00 are payable in a single installment and are due July 1, 2024.

### **No separate mailing will be sent for the second installment.**

The total Motor Vehicle tax is due July 1, 2024 and payable on August 1, 2024.

**Delinquent motor vehicle taxes shall be paid only in Cash, Money Order, or Bank Check if you require a release to register your motor vehicle.**

**Failure to receive a tax bill does not invalidate the tax and respective penalties should the account become delinquent. If you have purchased property you may need to contact the previous owner, your attorney, or the Town to procure the bill, or to determine the amount due.**

**If you pay your taxes by check, it is your responsibility to make sure your check has cleared. The Tax Office cannot be responsible for lost mail.**

Checks in payment of property taxes which have been returned by the bank shall be subject to a thirty-five (\$35.00) handling fee.

Unpaid taxes will be considered delinquent as of August 2, 2024. On that date, interest will be charged from the original due date of July 1, 2024. Interest is charged at a rate of 18% per year in accordance with the provisions of C.G.S. Sec. 12-146.

Payments may be made in person between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday at 45 So. Main St. Room 209. **(Noon hour included)** You may also use the "Payment" slot on the Prince Street side of the Town Hall next to the sliding glass doors.
