Valid for any Wallingford Electric Division ("WED") residential electric service customers ("Customer") who has attic and/or ceiling insulation installed by a licensed contractor on or after January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2026. All Residential Insulation Rebate requests ("Application") with required documentation must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2027.

### TO APPLY FOR YOUR REBATE, READ THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON REVERSE SIDE BEFORE PROCEEDING.

Customers must have participated in WED's Home Energy Solutions ("HES") Program to be eligible for the Residential Insulation Rebate.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Rebates are available to any WED residential service Customer who has attic and/or ceiling insulation installed by a licensed contractor at the premises indicated on this Application.

**EXCEPTIONS:** Insulation required by building codes for new homes or additions is not eligible for this rebate.

**REBATE OFFER:** Details of this rebate, including the *Efficiency Levels* and *Incentive* amounts, are subject to change without prior notice. **Funding for this program is limited to the period indicated or while funds last.** 

HES ASSESSMENT: The Customer must participate in WED's *Home Energy Solutions* (HES) program and have a free energy-use assessment and weatherization services completed on their home prior to installing the insulation. To schedule an appointment call WED's HES provider, CMC Energy Services, directly at (203) 294-9677.

**ATTIC INSULATION:** As determined during the *HES Assessment* the existing attic insulation must be have an R-value of 19 or less. A sufficient amount of insulation must be added to increase the R-value to 38 or greater.

**CEILING INSULATION:** As determined during the *HES Assessment* the ceiling cavity must be uninsulated and separate an unconditioned space (i.e., basement, garage, crawl space) from a conditioned space. In addition, the walls surrounding the unconditioned space must be uninsulated. Insulation with an R-value of 19 or greater must be installed in the ceiling cavity.

**APPLICATION:** This Application must be filled out completely and accurately. The Customer and Contractor must each sign and date the Application then submit it along with the PROOF OF PURCHASE requirements listed below. The rebate cannot exceed 100% of the total installation cost of the insulation. **APPLICATION DEADLINE:** A completed Application and PROOF OF PURCHASE showing that insulation was installed by a licensed contractor between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2026 must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2027. PROOF OF PURCHASE: A contractor's invoice listing the customer's address, type of insulation installed, material thickness, areas insulated, and date of installation must be submitted with the Application. PAYMENT: The Town of Wallingford will mail a check approximately 6 to 8 weeks after the Application is submitted. Payment processing may take longer if information is missing or the Application is not signed.

APPROVAL AND VERIFICATION: WED reserves

the right to verify all sales transaction and to have reasonable access to the residence to inspect the insulation installed under this Program prior to issuing rebates and for up to one year after date of Application. WED makes no warranties or representations of any kind, whether statutory, expressed, or implied for the performance or installation of the insulation as a result of the approval and verification process. The Customer also grants WED the right to confidentially share account information internally for payment processing procedures.

TAX LIABILITY: WED will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Customer as a result of the payment of rebates.

ENDORSEMENT: WED does not endorse any particular manufacturer, contractor, vendor, product, retailer or system design in promoting this Program.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: WED's liability is limited to paying the rebates specified. WED is not liable for any damages arising out of or resulting from participation in this rebate offer, including but not limited to loss of profits, loss of revenues, failure to realize expected savings, loss of data, loss of business opportunity, or similar losses of any kind, as well as any indirect, incidental, punitive, special, or consequential damages, or for any damages in tort connected with or resulting from participation in this Program.

Applicant understands that all funding for rebates under this program derives from the Energy Conservation Fund which is managed, in part, by WED and funded, in part, by its customers. WED does not guarantee the availability of funding for the program and is not responsible for any costs or damages incurred by applicant if funding for this program or the Energy Conservation Fund is reduced or eliminated. Funding is subject to change at any time without notice.

WED makes no warranties or representations of any kind, whether statutory, expressed, or implied, including without limitations, warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose regarding the System or services provided by a manufacturer, contractor or vendor. #### FORWARD CAPACITY MARKET AND CLASS III CREDITS: ISO-NE CAPACITY PAYMENTS:
