Valid for all Wallingford Electric Division ("WED") residential electric service customers ("Customer") who have a qualifying high efficiency electric heating and/or cooling system ("System") installed by a licensed contractor on or after January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. All Electric Residential Heating and Cooling System Rebate requests ("Application") with required documentation must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2026. PLEASE READ THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON REVERSE SIDE BEFORE PROCEEDING.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY: Rebates are available to all WED residential service Customers who have qualifying systems installed by licensed contractors at the premises indicated on this Application. Completed Applications and Proof of Purchase showing that qualifying systems were installed between January 31, 2025 and December 31, 2025 must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2026.

QUALIFYING STSTEM: Any contractor-installed residential split system central air conditioner, split system air source heat pump, or mini split (aka ductless) heat pump that meets or exceeds the MINIMUM EFFICIENCY LEVELS shown below and are a matched assembly where the condenser unit and evaporator coil are installed simultaneously.

MATCHED ASSEMBLY: A condenser unit and evaporator coil combination that is tested in accordance with ANSI/AHRI STANDARD 210/240-2017 and is listed in the AHRI1 Directory of Certified Product Performance. Test must include furnace and other system components that impact the performance rating.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Pre-approval from WED is not required. After the qualifying system is installed the Customer and Contractor must complete, sign and date this Application then submit to WED along with the PROOF OF PURCHASE listed below. PROOF OF PURCHASE: The following Support Documentation is required:

- 1) A contractor's invoice listing the purchase price, equipment type, date of purchase, address where qualifying system was installed, condenser make and model number, and coil or fan make and model number.
- 2) An AHRI Certificate of Product Rating that includes the SEER2, EER3 and HSPF4 ratings for the qualifying system.

3) A copy of the Owner's recent electric bill. **REBATE OFFER:** Details of this rebate, including the MINIMUM EFFICIENCY LEVELS and REBATE amounts, are subject to change without prior notice. Rebate cannot exceed the total installed cost of the qualifying system. Funding for Residential Electric Heating & Cooling System Rebates is limited to the period indicated or while funds last. **PAYMENT:** The Town of Wallingford will mail a check to the customer for the rebate amount about 6 to 8 weeks after the Application is submitted. Payment processing may take longer if information is missing or the Application is not signed.

CUSTOMER'S CERTIFICATION: By signing this Application the Customer certifies that the qualifying system was installed by a licensed contractor at the premises indicated.

CONTRACTOR'S CERTIFICATION: By signing this Application the Contractor certifies that they are licensed to work in the State of Connecticut and that the qualifying system was installed at the premises indicated in accordance with local building codes and the manufacturer's instructions.

APPROVAL AND VERIFICATION: WED reserves

the right to verify sales transaction and to have reasonable access to your residence to inspect the System installed under this Program prior to issuing rebates and for up to one year after date of Application. WED makes no warranties or representations of any kind, whether statutory, expressed, or implied for the performance or installation of the equipment as a result of the approval and verification process. The Customer also grants WED the right to confidentially share account number information internally for payment processing procedures.

TAX LIABILITY: WED will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Customer as a result of the payment of rebates. ENDORSEMENT: WED does not endorse any particular manufacturer, contractor, vendor, product, retailer or system design in promoting this Program. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: WED's liability is limited to paying the rebates specified. WED is not liable for any damages arising out of or resulting from participation in this rebate offer, including but not limited to loss of profits, loss of revenues, failure to realize expected savings, loss of data, loss of business opportunity, or similar losses of any kind, as well as any indirect, incidental, punitive, special, or consequential damages, or for any damages in tort connected with or resulting from participation in this Program.

By signing this document, and as a condition to receiving a rebate pursuant to this program, the Customer acknowledges and agrees that any and all payments, benefits and/or credits associated with or applicable to the Customer's participation in the program that is the subject of this Agreement in connection with the ISO New England, Inc. Forward Capacity Market ("FCM") or any existing, successor or replacement markets, (including, but not limited to, any and all transitional FCM credits or payments or any and all other capacity-related credits, payments and/or benefits for which such Customer is eligible) shall be deemed as and form capacity payments, credits and/or benefits of WED. The Customer hereby assigns to WED all of its right, title and interest in and to any and all such capacity payments, credits and/or benefits, and agrees to take any and all action, including executing and delivering any and all documentation and/or instruments, as requested by WED to evidence the same. FCM means the market for procuring capacity pursuant to ISO-NE Tariff, FERC Electric Tariff No. 3, Section III, Market Rule 1, Section 13, any modifications to the FCM, or any successor or replacement market/capacity procurement process.

CLASS III CONSERVATION CREDITS: Any Class III renewable energy credits and/or conservation credits received in connection with this program shall be retained by WED pursuant to the laws of the State of Connecticut as of the date hereof.
