Mayor Cervoni announced that a 9-11 Remembrance Ceremony will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 11, 2024, in front of the Wallingford Town Hall. Citizens are invited to attend the Remembrance Ceremony and gather together to honor and pay tribute to all those affected by the events of September 11, 2001. The Program will include posting of the Colors, students from Lyman Hall High School and Mark T. Sheehan High School as speakers as well as other meaningful tributes.

Pursuant to Chapter 216 of the Wallingford Town Code, the following road closures and parking prohibitions will be in effect on Wednesday, September 11, 2024 to facilitate the ceremony:

**South Main Street** between its intersection with Center Street and Prince Street will be closed to all motor vehicle traffic starting at 9:30 a.m. Parking will be prohibited on South Main Street starting at 9:00 a.m.

In case of inclement weather, the program will be held in the Robert F. Parisi Town Council Chambers and South Main Street will remain open. This event is sponsored by the Wallingford Fire Department, Wallingford Police Department and Public Celebrations Committee.
