

The Twelfth Budget Workshop of the Wallingford Town Council was held on Monday, May 11, 1992 in the Robert Earley Auditorium of the Wallingford Town Hall and called to Order at 7:44 P.M. by Chairperson Iris F. Papale. Answering present to the Roll called by Town Clerk Kathryn J. Wall were Councilors Doherty, Duryea, Holmes, McDermott, Papale and Parisi. Councilors Killen, Solinsky & Zandri were absent. Mayor William W. Dickinson, Jr. and Comptroller Thomas A. Myers were also present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given to the Flag.

CAPITAL & NON-RECURRING

Motion was made by Mr. Doherty to Remove \$150,000 from the General Fund set aside for the WPL-TV and create a line item under the Capital & Non-Recurring Fund to read T.V. Station Relocation and fund it in the amount of \$148,500, seconded by Mr. McDermott

VOTE: Killen, Solinsky and Zandri were absent; all others, aye; motion duly carried.

OTHER

Motion was made by Mr. Doherty to Apply \$586,000 in State Funds available to Wallingford through the ECS (\$455,382) and Welfare (\$130,000) Programs to the Mill Rate to Reduce it from 24.2 under the Mayor's Proposed Budget to 24 Mills, seconded by Mrs. Duryea.

VOTE: Killen, Solinsky and Zandri were absent; Holmes and Parisi, no; all others, aye; motion failed.

Motion was made by Mr. McDermott to Decrease Contingency Acct. #3190 by \$6,000 to Balance the Budget with the Final Amount to Be Determined by Comptroller Thomas A. Myers.

VOTE: Killen, Solinsky and Zandri were absent; all others, aye; motion duly carried.

Motion was made by Mr. McDermott to Adjourn the Meeting, seconded by Mr. Parisi.

VOTE: Killen, Solinsky and Zandri were absent; all others, aye; motion duly carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:40 P.M.
