Attached for your review and approval is a budget transfer request to fund secretarial and miscellaneous expenses for the Charter Revision Commission. This funding is required to support the activities of the Commission for the balance of fiscal 1988-89; secretarial services will be used for public hearings and regular full commissions, while miscellaneous expenses will cover the cost of such items as publication of public hearing notices and postage.
