After reviewing all of the data submitted by the Wallingford Police Department and Dr. Nicoletti of the Wallingford Board of Education, the following investigative steps are recommended:

1. Take statements from the other computer vendors involved in this matter (IBM, Hewlett Packard, etc.). Phone conversations are quoted but not documented.
2. Arrange for an independent computer specialist to examine the specifications that WBOE published, to determine whether the scope was so narrow as to preclude others from a successful bid.
3. Interview Wallingford Board of Education personnel, as well as Town Council members.

Although a possibility of several statutory violations, both criminal and civil, exists, further investigatory efforts as outlined above are necessary before any further evaluation by this office.
