Dear Mr. Killen:

In your letter of February 28, 1992, you posed the following question:

Does the Mayor have the authority to fix the tax rate in mills, and where in the Charter of the Town of Wallingford does it lie?


ANSWER: Yes, in Chapter XV, Section 4.

EXPLANATION:

Chapter XV, Section 4, provides that if the Town Council fails to adopt a budget in accordance with that section and Chapter III, Section 7, the mayor's proposed budget is deemed to be finally adopted by the Council, and the section goes on to say that the Mayor then sets the tax rate. The failure of the Town Council to override the Mayor's veto constitutes a failure to adopt a budget and the budget is adopted as outlined above.
